

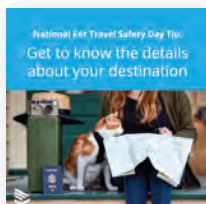

January 2nd is National Pet Travel Safety Day!

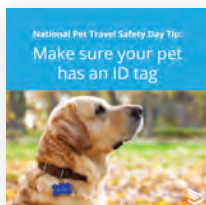

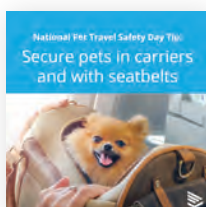

January 2nd is National Pet Travel Safety Day!

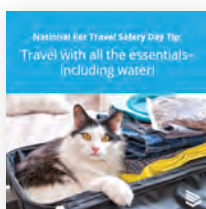

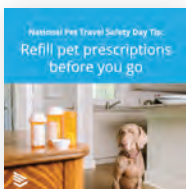
